AGM DAY 2020 – SUNDAY 29th NOVEMBER

In compliance with current regulations in regard to organised gatherings of people, the Club's Annual General Meeting (AGM) will take place in an entirely different format this year.

As we cannot meet face-to-face yet, we will have an AGM Day instead! All normal documentation will be available on or before the designated day. The one Agenda item that will be different is the Election of Officers – as we have no officers currently tied to a five-year term, we have obtained leave to defer the Election of Officers until such time as it is safe to hold this part of the AGM face-to-face or until it is possible to have a 'Personal Delivered Vote'.

In all other respects, the AGM will proceed on what has been designated 'AGM Day'. Minutes of 2019 AGM, Secretary's Report and Chairperson's Address will be circulated ten days prior to the designated day – Clonduff's Designated Day is Sunday 29th November 2020.

The Annual Accounts will be available for viewing on 29th November in foyer of clubrooms – members who wish to view **must make an appointment** which will be available in 10-minute intervals. **To book a slot please call Daniel on 07707076153.**

A specific question box will be provided for members who wish to query the financial statements. Pen (sanitised after each use) and paper will be provided on the day. Those wishing to view the accounts or leave a comment/query must wear a face mask.

There will be two further boxes provided on AGM Day:

1. Members recommendations for the incoming year
2. Questions/Queries/Comments re Secretary's Report and Chairperson's Address

Questions/Queries/Comments in all three boxes must clearly show the name of the member. Club Executive will endeavour to answer these within 10-14 days. Questions/queries/Comments without a name will have to be disregarded.

On the first full Executive Meeting in early December they will on your behalf:

1. Re-affirm Commitment to GAA Constitution
2. Adopt the Standing Orders
3. Adopt the Minutes of 2019 AGM
4. Adopt the Secretary's Report 2020
5. Adopt the Financial Statements 2020
6. Adopt the Chairperson's Address
7. Answer your Questions/Queries to the best of their abilities and communicate asap after that meeting

Also, in the interests of the health and safety of our community, Executive Decisions were made to:

- Cancel the Annual Halloween Fireworks Display and Halloween Sports Camp
- Cancel the Annual Awards for both Juveniles and Adults
- Defer the Annual Deceased Members Mass – If this cannot take place in early January 2021 as the usual stand-alone Mass, Fr Charlie has agreed that our deceased members will be included in a regular Saturday evening or Sunday Morning Mass
